This is therefore an exciting time to be part of a new kitchen set up and be at the forefront of further raising the overall standards of the food and service to the highest level.

The successful candidate will be a highly motivated individual with a passion for delivering a high standard of customer care. Applicants should have a friendly flexible working attitude, good communication skills and a willingness to learn new skills.

This is a permanent, full-time post averaging 40 hours per week which will normally be worked across a 2 week shift system comprising mainly of working straight shifts and alternate weekend working. There is a need for flexibility to meet unpredictable operational demands in the College. The salary is £20,592 per annum at £9.90 per hour.
