Sidney Sussex College, is seeking to appoint a number of Housekeeping Assistants to work within the Accommodation Department. These posts will report to the Head of Accommodation, and will help to ensure the highest possible standard of cleaning is maintained throughout the College buildings and outlying hostels.

There are a range of full-time and part-time, permanent posts available. Full-time is 37.5 hpw.

All posts will be worked 5 days in 7, with occasional weekend work required.

Benefits include an annual leave entitlement of 25 days holiday plus 8 bank holidays (pro rata for part-time); an excellent contributory pension scheme provided by the Universities Superannuation Scheme (USS), free College meals when on duty, College uniform and subsidised membership of the College's gym facilities.

These posts would suit a pro-active, professional individual with a strong work ethic. Experience of professional cleaning work in an educational or hotel establishment would be useful to the role but training will be provided. The ability to work unsupervised, and capacity to travel daily to outlying hostels would be welcomed.
